# SMS(S) CCA **POLICY**



# ONE CCA ATTENDANCE

School-based CCA is compulsory.

Every student must participate in at least one school-based CCA.

Student needs to have minimum of 75% attendance annually.

# **ABSENCE**

Absence from CCA must be supported with MCs or parent's letter.

Only 4 parent's letters are accepted in a year.



### REQUEST



### **PROBATION**



### **TRANSFER**

A student may request for a transfer only with a valid reason.

Request can be made at end of the year.

Student needs to serve probation for a term (10 weeks), subject to vacancy availability.

Student should attend regularly and display positive learning attitude.

Student will transfer to new CCA if she passes the probation.

# 05 CCA REGISTRATION EXPERIENCE

### 2024 SMS(S) S1 CCA Registration Experience Schedule

#### CCA Info (Self-directed)

8 Jan to 10 Jan

Students can access Student Learning Space (SLS) to learn independently about the 23 CCAs offered in SMS(S).

#### **CCA Fair**

10 Jan (7.30am - 4.30pm)

Students will attend a physical CCA Fair to learn about the different CCAs offered by the school. There will also be CCA showcase segments for students to participate and experience. Students will also be briefed on the school's CCA policies. Details on CCA Fair will be shared with Sec 1s on 8 Jan.

#### **CCA Trials**

12 Jan to 22 Jan

CCA Trials sign-up starts on Mon 8 Jan 5pm to Wed 10 Jan 11.59pm. Students are highly encouraged to plan and sign up (online) for trials conducted within the above-mentioned period. Students can expect to complete several tasks that would test both their aptitude and specific skills to assess their talent and potential. Concurrently, teachers use this opportunity to identify students who possess potential in the respective CCAs for the subsequent phases. The CCA Trial sign-up instructions and sign-up link will be available on SLS and on our school website.

#### **CCA Trials Acceptance Phase**

23 Jan to 25 Jan

Students will be informed if they have been offered a CCA based on their trial performance. Those who have been offered more than one CCA must accept no more than one CCA during this stage using an online form sent to them.

#### **CCA Registration Phase**

26 Jan to 29 Jan

All students who have not been allocated a CCA previously, through DSA or CCA Trials Acceptance Phase, must participate in this phase. Students will need to submit up to six CCA choices that include at least one Club, Visual or Performing Art, Sport or Uniformed Group CCA. Students will receive their CCA Allocation Results by 1 Feb.



# CCA Trial Acceptance Period

### CCA Trial Results Release & Acceptance Period

- Students will be informed <u>if they have received</u> any CCA offers based on their CCA Trial results from **Tue 23 Jan to Thu 25 Jan 12pm**.
- If they have been offered a CCA, they must <u>acknowledge</u> by choosing not more than one CCA on the online form by Thu 25 Jan, 6pm.
- Students who have not received any CCA offers must <u>participate in</u> the CCA Registration Phase.





# CCA Registration 2024

- 1. DSA students and students selected during CCA Trials are not required to do CCA Registration.
- 2. During CCA Registration<sup>4</sup>, Students must select up to <u>6 choices</u>.
- 3. For their top 4 choices, students must choose <u>one CCA</u> <u>from each the following CCA categories</u>: Physical Sports; Visual & Performing Arts; Uniformed Groups.

# Focus in 2024

Fostering a Positive and Caring School Culture in CCA.

Creating a safe and conducive CCA environment for our students, by strengthening CCA routines and structures, CCA Teacher-Student Relationships, & Peer Support Relationships.

Supporting the Holistic Development of our Students in CCA through a more Holistic CCA Assessment.



Question: Is CCA participation in school compulsory? Must my child/ward participate in a school-based CCA?

CCA is an integral part of the student's holistic education in school. Hence, CCA participation is compulsory at the secondary school level, and every student is expected to participate in a CCA from one of the four CCA categories (Sports, C&S, UG and VPA).

Participation in a school-based CCA allows the teachers to guide and chart the development of the student beyond the learning from the subject disciplines in the classroom, in areas such as leadership and character development, and the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Competencies (21CC).



Question: Can my child/ward participate in an external CCA?

A student may participate in a non-school-based CCA or a community-based activity to pursue his/her interests which are not offered in the school, but not in lieu of a CCA in school (school-based CCA). These external activities will mainly be interest-driven, and the additional participation will not contribute to a higher attainment level in the LEAPS 2.0 Participation Domain.



Question: Can my child/ward participate in a 2nd CCA in school?

With a second CCA, the student will have to commit more day(s) to spend in school for CCA. We do not recommend this so that the students can provide time to their academic studies and participation in other school activities/programmes.



Question: Will my child/ward be allocated a CCA of her choice?

The school will try its best to match your child/ward's interest and aptitude to the CCA allocated. However, in view of limited resources, it is not possible to accommodate every student's wish as there is a quota for every CCA to ensure their sustainability.



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
