Supporting Your Teen in Exploring Post-Secondary Pathways

Your teen will be pursuing their next phase of learning soon. You may be wondering about the various pathways available and how big a role you should play in helping them decide on their options.

Here is a <u>summary of the post-secondary options available</u> and 4 tips below on how you and your teen could explore them together.



1. Take a step back from your own expectations

Every teen is unique, including your own. Encourage them to think through their options by recognising their own strengths, interests and learning styles.

Do offer advice but avoid pressuring your teen to qualify for a certain pathway based on your own expectations and experiences.
