#### **Health Matters**

## **Practising Good Personal Hygiene**

Please continue to work with your daughter/ward in adherence to the spirit and intent of practising good personal hygiene, and to wash her hands frequently with soap and water. Students who are unwell should stay at home and seek medical attention where necessary.

#### Staying Hydrated

As the temperature continues to rise amidst climate change, please encourage your daughter/ward to stay hydrated and drink enough fluids before, during and after exercises to prevent and alleviate any heat strain.

#### **Haze Management**

As stated in the notification to parents sent out via Parents Gateway on Friday, 28 September, the school is prepared to respond and take appropriate haze management measures to ensure the well-being of students and staff. Teachers will be on the lookout for students who are unwell or have pre-existing lung or heart conditions. We will adjust school activities accordingly as needed.

Where applicable, please do ensure that your daughters have their necessary medication, such as inhalers for asthma, with them as required, and take them to seek medical attention if they are unwell or exhibit respiratory problems due to haze. MOE will consider school closure if NEA's air quality forecast for the next day is in the "Hazardous" range (24-hr PSI>300). Parents will be informed through Parents Gateway the evening before the closure.

#### 2. Post-examination Matters

There will be a series of activities after the End-of-Year Examinations. These activities include the checking of examination scripts, resumption of CCAs, enrichment programmes and curriculum time (which includes the Headstart Programme for Secondary 3 students). #### (i) Marking Days

Students are not required to attend school on Friday, 13 October and Monday, 16 October.

#### (ii) Checking of Scripts

Students will be checking their examination scripts on Tuesday, 17 October, and Wednesday, 18 October. Students are to report to school on both days by 7.30am instead of 8.40am.

## (iii) Resumption of CCAs

CCAs will resume from Tuesday, 17 October, unless communicated earlier by CCA teachers via Parents Gateway.

#### (iv) Headstart Programme and Study Camp

- The Headstart Programme will be conducted for all Secondary 3 students to provide them with a headstart on their Secondary 4 syllabuses.
- The Study Camp is designed for some Secondary 1, 2 and 3 students who do not perform satisfactorily in the End-of-Year Examinations. They will be required to attend the Study Camp to help them bridge their learning gaps. Students identified for this Study Camp will be notified after the release of the End-of-Year Examination results.
