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Information Note on 2019 Direct School Admission – Junior Colleges (DSA-JC) Exercise

Dear Student,

You will be completing your secondary education soon. At this juncture, you may wish to find out more about the Direct School Admission - Junior Colleges (DSA-JC) Exercise, which provides you an alternative avenue for seeking JC admission.

What is the DSA-JC Exercise?

2. Introduced in 2005, the DSA-JC Exercise provides students with the opportunity to seek admission to a Junior College (JC), based on a diverse range of academic and non-academic achievements and talents that they can demonstrate beyond the GCE 'O' Level Examination.

How is the DSA-JC Exercise conducted?

3. The 2019 DSA-JC Exercise will be conducted in two Phases according to the following schedule.

Phase	Stage	Dates	Remarks
Phase 1 & 2	Application		Application deadline for each DSA-JC school may be different. Students should visit the individual schools' website for information on application period, procedures and selection criteria.
Phase 1	Offer Stage	1 Jul to 30 Jul	Schools conduct selection and make Phase 1 offers during this stage.
	Acceptance Stage	31 Jul to 2 Aug	A student may accept only <u>one</u> Phase 1 offer within this stage, regardless of the number of offers received. Phase 1 offers that are not accepted expire at the end of this stage.
	Cooling-Off Stage	5 Aug to 7 Aug	Students may cancel earlier acceptance of Phase 1 offers if they wish to consider Phase 2 offers.
Phase 2	Offer Stage	5 Aug to 23 Aug	Schools make Phase 2 offers during this stage.
	Acceptance Stage	26 Aug to 29 Aug	A student who has yet to commit to an offer may accept only <u>one</u> Phase 2 offer within this period, regardless of the number of offers received.

4. You may find more details on the 2019 DSA-JC Exercise at **Annex A** and the list of participating schools and their websites at **Annex B**. You should check the detailed exercise schedule of the schools that you would like to apply to, by visiting their websites or contacting them directly way before the start of Phase 1. Please consider carefully what your own strengths are, and which school best meets your own needs, before you commit yourself to participating in tests or trials conducted by the schools.

5. By the end of the Offer Stage of each Phase, schools will make offers to their selected students. If you are selected by a school, you can decide whether to accept or reject the offer. If you accept an offer



before its expiry date, you will be guaranteed a place in the JC, so long as you meet the eligibility criteria for JC admission based on your GCE 'O' Level examination results¹. Please note that **you are NOT allowed to accept more than one offer at any time**. If you do so, you will be disqualified from the DSA-JC Exercise, and will have to participate in the Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE) if you still wish to seek JC admission.

6. **Once you have accepted an offer under the DSA-JC Exercise, you are not allowed to participate in the JAE** if you meet the eligibility criteria for JC admission based on your GCE 'O' Level examination results. **You are also not allowed to transfer to another school after the release of the GCE 'O' Level examination results as you are expected to honour your commitment to the DSA-JC school**. Hence, please consider very carefully before you accept an offer to be admitted to a school under the DSA-JC Exercise.

7. Students who change their mind after accepting an offer and wish to withdraw from the 2019 DSA-JC Exercise have to submit their withdrawals personally to the **MOE Customer Service Centre**, no later than **11 Oct 2019, 5pm**. Once you have submitted your withdrawal from the DSA-JC Exercise, you will be allowed to participate in the JAE.

Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)

8. 'O' Level students who wish to gain admission to a polytechnic can also participate in the Polytechnic EAE (Poly EAE), which will commence on **27 Jun 2019**, for admission in **AY2020**.

9. Students may also participate in the Institute of Technical Education EAE (ITE EAE) if they wish to gain admission to ITE. Applications open on **21 May 2019**, for admission in **AY2020**.

10. If you have accepted an EAE offer from a polytechnic or ITE and have met the criteria for admission to the course you have been offered, you will be guaranteed a place in that polytechnic or ITE course and you will not be allowed to participate in the JAE.

Participation in DSA-JC and EAE

11. Students can participate in the DSA-JC Exercise and EAE concurrently. However, they may accept only one offer i.e. either a DSA-JC or EAE offer. Students found to have accepted both DSA-JC and EAE offers concurrently will be disqualified from these exercises, unless they cancel either of their offers before the end of the Acceptance Stage.

¹ Students who do not meet the eligibility criteria for JC admission based on their GCE 'O' Level examination results will not be admitted to the JC under the DSA-JC Exercise. These students may participate in the Joint Admissions Exercise to seek admission to MI, Polytechnics, or ITE, if they qualify for a course offered by the institution.

	<p>Students who wish to participate in the Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE) must submit their withdrawals from 2019 DSA-JC Exercise by 11 Oct 2019, 5.00pm.</p> <p>Students successfully admitted to a school via the DSA-JC Exercise are not allowed to participate in the annual JAE. They are also not allowed to transfer to another school after the release of the GCE 'O' Level examination results. They are expected to honour the commitment to the DSA-JC schools</p>
