## Viewing of Results Online (Singpass)

All students will be able to view their results for the 2020 N-Level examinations online, via SEAB's results release system:

1. Website: [www.seab.gov.sg](http://www.seab.gov.sg)
2. Time: from 2.30pm from 17 (to 31 Dec 2020)
3. Access: Singpass or system-generated password from SEAB

*Note:*

*Students will still have to collect their hardcopy results and the Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) Forms from school.*

Collection of hardcopy results and JIE forms can be done via the following options:

1. Collection of results on 17 December in the classrooms between 2.00 – 3.30 pm
2. Collection of results from 17 December (3.30pm onwards) to 21 December at the General Office

## Collection of Results on 17 Dec 2020 (in the classrooms)

1. Students may collect their results in person in school on 17 December.
2. Due to the current **Safe Management Measures** to discourage large gathering of people, only students who are collecting their results will be allowed entry into the school premises.
3. Students to report to school not earlier than 1.30 pm.
4. Students to scan **SafeEntry** and do temperature check at the school's main entrance before reporting to respective form classrooms. When at their classrooms, students are to show the SafeEntry screen to Form Teachers and sit according to index number.
5. Students who are not properly attired in school uniform and/or with coloured hair will be turned away at the main gate.
