Collection of Results

Collection of hardcopy results and Form A can be done via the following options:

1. On **12 January** between **2.00pm to 3.15pm** in the hall
2. From **12 January** (3.30pm onwards) to **16 January** at the General Office



Collection of Results

- *All students will have to collect their hardcopy results and the Form A from school within 3 working days.*
- *Students who are unable to collect their results in person should inform their Form Teacher (FT) and can appoint a proxy to collect the physical copy of their results on their behalf. (Proxy forms can be requested via FTs)*
- *Proxies are required to produce the relevant documents for the school's verification when collecting the results.*

Collection of Results from 12 – 16 Jan 2023 (General Office)

- Students or *proxies may collect the results and Form A from the school within 3 working days at the following timings at the General Office.

Date	Collection Time
12 January 2023	3.30 pm – 5.00 pm
13 & 16 January 2023	8.00 am – 5.00 pm

Collection of Results on 12 Jan 2023 (in the hall)

1. Students are to report to school no earlier than 1.15pm. This is to allow the current (S1 to S3) students sufficient time to leave school and to minimise congestion.
2. Students are to report to the hall and sit with their classes according to index number.
3. **Students who are not properly attired in school uniform and/or with coloured hair will not be allowed to join their class.**
4. Parents/guardians who are accompanying their daughter/ward are welcomed to join them in the hall.

Viewing of Results Online (Singpass)

All students will be able to view their results for the 2022 O-Level examinations online, via SEAB's Candidates Portal:

1. Website: www.seab.gov.sg
2. Time: from 2.45pm on 12 Jan (to 26 Jan 2023)
3. Access: Singpass or system-generated password from SEAB
 - *Students who are eligible for Singpass are to apply and activate their Singpass account so that they can view their results online. For students whose Singpass PIN had expired, they can reset their password instantly online or request for a new PIN mailer via Singpass website (www.singpass.gov.sg).*
 - *For candidates who are not eligible for Singpass, i.e. International Students, SEAB will send a system-generated username to their email address on 9 Jan 2023.*

- Students who wish to apply for admission to Junior Colleges (JC), Millennia Institute (MI), Polytechnics and Institute of Technical Education (ITE) may do so via the Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE) using their GCE O-Level examination results.
- The JAE-IS will be accessible from 3.00pm on 12 Jan 2023 to 4.00pm on 17 Jan 2023 for students to submit their course choices through the JAE website at www.moe.gov.sg/jae.
