Collection of Results



Collection of hardcopy results and Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) forms can be done via the following options:

- 1. On 19 December** between **2.00pm to 3.00pm** in the classrooms (*Students are to report by 1.30pm*)
- 2. From 19 December** (3.00pm onwards) **to 22 December** at the General Office



Collection of Results

- *All students will have to collect their hardcopy results and the JIE Forms from school.*
- *Students who are unable to collect their results in person should inform their Form Teacher (FT) and can appoint a proxy to collect the physical copy of their results on their behalf. (Proxy forms can be requested via FTs)*
- *Proxies are required to produce the relevant documents for the school's verification when collecting the results.*



Collection of Results from 19 – 22 Dec 2022 (General Office)

- Students or *proxies may collect the results and the hardcopy of the JIE forms from the school at the following timing at the General Office.

Date	Collection Time
19 December 2022	3.00 pm – 5.00 pm
20 - 22 December 2022	8.00 am – 5.00 pm

*Proxies are to bring along the completed Proxy Form and their relevant documents



Collection of Results on 19 Dec 2022 (in the classrooms)



1. Students are to report to school no earlier than 12.30pm. The side gate will only be opened at 1.00pm.
2. Only students who are collecting their results will be allowed to enter the classrooms.
3. Students are to report to their respective form classrooms and are to sit according to index number.
4. **Students who are not properly attired in school uniform and/or with coloured hair will not be allowed to collect their results in the classrooms at 2.00pm.**
5. Parents/guardians who are accompanying their daughter/ward are to wait in the canteen.

School candidates who are unwell or self-isolating due to a positive COVID-19 test result should not return to school to collect their results and should view their results online instead.



Viewing of Results Online (Singpass)



All students will be able to view their results for the 2022 N-Level examinations online, via SEAB's results release system:

1. Website: www.seab.gov.sg
2. Time: from 2.45pm on 19 Dec (to 30 Dec 2022)
3. Access: Singpass or system-generated password from SEAB
 - *Students who are eligible for Singpass are to apply and activate their Singpass account so that they can view their results online. For students whose Singpass PIN has expired, they can request for a new PIN mailer via Singpass website (www.singpass.gov.sg) or visit any Singpass Counter in-person to set up their Singpass account.*
 - *School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via email from Wednesday, 14 December 2022.*
